

Appalachia High Electronics Policy

Electronic devices (cell phones, I-pods, mp3 players, cameras, etc) are not permitted in the classroom during instructional time unless the teacher has the permission of the office. If a student refuses to follow the electronics policy, the following consequences will occur:

First offence – the item is confiscated and the student may retrieve the item from the office at the end of the day.

Second offence – the item is confiscated and the student's parent / guardian is contacted. The parent / guardian must come to the school to retrieve the item.

Third offence – the item is confiscated and the student's parent / guardian is contacted. The parent / guardian must come to the school to retrieve the item. The student is also suspended for one day.

In addition, use of the school computers for inappropriate use will not be tolerated. Students who use school computers in this manner will be dealt with by the school's administration. Depending on circumstances, inappropriate use may lead to a student being banned from using school computers.
